## 2 Installation/upgrade notes

Some of the following issues are not new, but is still repeated in the release notes for the sake of new readers.

#### 2.1 Update the permission set on new releases


The About page (in the OAS Options dialog) will now show the discrepancies by displaying

a warning sign next to any module where the latest script is not executed (i.e. grants are missing), like shown above.

By hovering over the warning sign, the tooltip will show what scripts has to be executed.

Note that this doesn't mean that OAS will not work at all, but that some functionality could fail if not updated. If one or more warning signs shows up, you should execute the latest grant scripts.


The scripts can be executed from the OAS Options | Tools page | PL\*SQL dialog provided you have the password for the application owner account in IFS.



The scripts needed comes with the installation files.

#### 2.2 Missing certificate

Missing Certificate has turned out to be a major cause of the OAS addins to be disabled, especially in Microsoft Office Outlook. We have now added a warning button in the OAS ribbon | General button group that is made visible if the certificate is missing. Although it is not required to install the certificate for the addin to work properly, we strongly recommend to do so to avoid any issues because of the missing certificate. You can read more about this in the installation guide.
